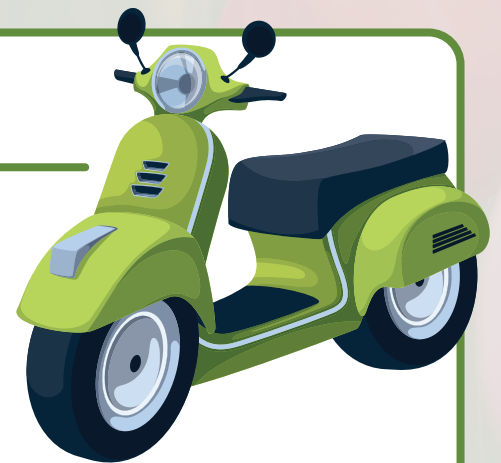
E-Scooter Safety

Key Information for Texas Parents and Riders

In Texas, particularly in Fort Bend County, there has been a noticeable increase in safety concerns regarding the use of electric scooters and motorcycles among children and teens. It is crucial for parents and riders to be aware of the laws and safety guidelines to prevent accidents and ensure responsible riding.

Current Issues with Electric Scooters and Motorcycles

- Rising Complaints:** Law enforcement has reported a significant uptick in complaints regarding reckless riding, particularly among kids riding electric motorcycles without proper understanding of the laws. Many of these vehicles can exceed speeds of 70 mph, creating a serious safety hazard in neighborhoods.
- Legal Distinction:** Parents often mistake electric motorcycles for e-bikes. However, if the vehicle lacks pedals, it is classified as a motorcycle and comes with strict regulations. This distinction is crucial as riding an unlawful vehicle can lead to citations that affect a teen's future ability to obtain a driver's license. *(continued on page 3)*

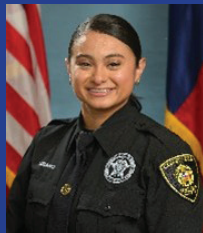

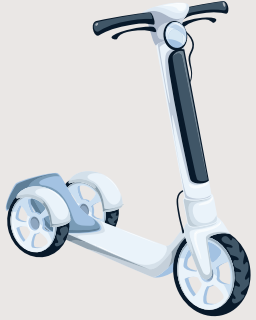

E-Scooter Safety *(Continued from Cover.)*

Safety Regulations for Riders

1. **Licensing and Registration:** Riders must have a valid driver's license to operate these vehicles, and the motorcycles must be registered and insured.



2. **Traffic Laws:** All standard traffic laws apply to electric motorcycles. They should not be ridden on sidewalks, trails, or busy roadways without proper authorization.
3. **Potential Consequences:** Violations can lead to fines, and repeated infractions might hinder a young person's ability to secure a driver's license at age 16.

Recommendations for Parents

- **Education:** Discuss the risks and legal responsibilities associated with riding electric scooters or motorcycles with your children.
- **Encouragement of Safe Practices:** Emphasize the importance of wearing helmets and following traffic rules.
- **Community Alternatives:** Advocate for designated riding areas. Many community members suggest creating safe spaces for riding to mitigate risks on public roads.

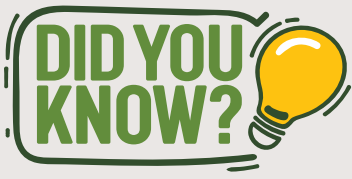

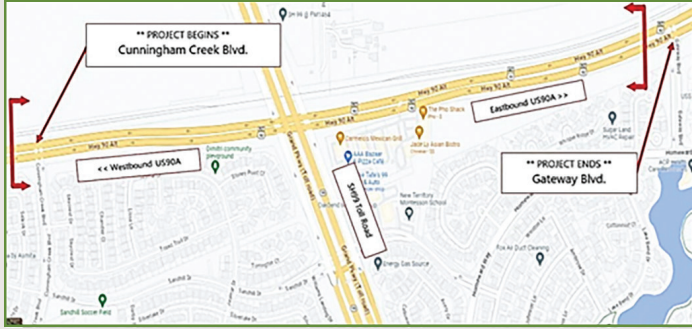

It's Almost Finished



TxDOT started a 29-month roadway project in September, 2023 to improve drainage and mobility on US90A near SH99 in Sugar Land.

The reconstruction project starts at the Cunningham Creek Blvd. intersection and ends just west of the Gateway Blvd. intersection.

The current roadway has 4 lanes and has an average right-of-way width of 175 feet. Drainage is primarily open ditches with short section of curb-and-gutter between Cunningham Creek drive and SH 99.

Proposed improvements between SH 6 and SH 99 include: Expand to 8-lane divided roadway with raised media

- Curb-and-gutter drainage
- About a half-acre of right-of-way would be required at various points along southern edge of existing right-of-way

Important News for Golf Cart Owners

This month we must let you know that the parking of golf carts (covered/uncovered) on your lot or driveway and visible from the street falls into the same category and is a deed restriction that could lead to a fine.

Impossible Taco Pie

This is a great recipe to have on hand if you are in a hurry.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 pound ground beef
- ½ cup chopped onion
- 1 envelope (1-1/2 ounces) taco seasoning mix
- 1 can (4 ounces) chopped green chilies, drained
- 1-1/4 cups milk
- ¾ cup Bisquick Baking Mix
- 3 eggs
- 2 tomatoes, sliced
- 1 cup shredded Monterey Jack or Cheddar Cheese (about 4-5 ounces)



INSTRUCTIONS:

Heat oven to 400 degrees. Lightly grease 10 x 1-1/2-inch pie plate. Cook and stir ground beef and onion in 10-inch skillet until beef is brown and drain. Stir in taco seasoning mix. Spread in pie plate and sprinkle with chilies. Beat milk, baking mix, and eggs until smooth (15 seconds in blender or 1 minute with hand beater. Pour into pie place. Bake 25 minutes.

Top with tomatoes and sprinkle with cheese. Continue baking until cheese is golden brown and knife inserted halfway between center and edge comes out clean (about 8 – 10 minutes). Let stand 5 minutes before cutting. Serve with sour cream, chopped tomatoes and shredded lettuce.
