

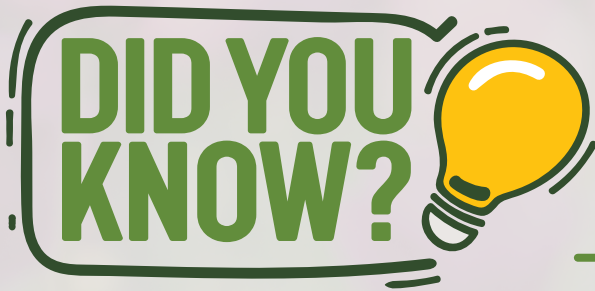

Are You Feeding Feral Cats?

Remember that every cat deserves proper veterinary care. Feeding without fixing leads to more homeless kittens in your neighborhood. **Before you decide to feed, please contact Fort Bend County Animal Services to make a real difference for feral or stray cats by joining the Trap-Neuter-Return Program.** Talk to your neighbors to determine whether the cats are pets, stray, or feral and if they have been spayed/neutered. LISTEN. Try to understand – explain TNR and how your work is helping. Seek solutions. Don't meet hostility with hostility.

Also, if you are feeding feral cats, they need a place to go:

- Peat moss
- Sandbox
- Litterbox in a storage bin

This program is for feral cats only, not owned cats. The cat's ear will be tipped. The Ft. Bend County Animal Services Trap-Neuter-Return/Shelter-Neuter-Return program includes spay/neuter surgery, ear tip, rabies vaccination and the returned to the general area or pick-up option.

Pick-Up & Drop-Off

- Pick Up (TNR Cats) Tuesday, call 8-10 AM. Cats must be in a live-release trap. No trap – no pick up
- Drop-Off (TNR Cats) Wednesday 8-8:30 AM at the shelter. Cats must be in a trap. No trap – not accepted.
- Return/Pick-Up Options Thursday, 10 AM-4PM at shelter or request drop-off at your address. If picking up, it must be you or someone at the same address on driver's license.

Other Guidelines:

- One cat per address per week
- Traps can be loaned for \$100 check deposit (returned when trap is returned)
- You may also purchase your own humane trap

Steps for Humanely Deterring Cats - AKA Neighbor Relations

Talk to your neighbors to determine whether the cats you are about to feed are their pets, stray, or feral. If you have joined the Trap-Neuter-Return program, explain to them how your work is helping. Seek solutions. Don't meet hostility with hostility. Giving them the following information might help with "neighbor relations".

How to Keep Cats Out of Gardens and Yards

Physical Barriers:

- Car cover
- Purrfect Fence
- Cat Scat (view at gardeners.com)
- Cat proof fencing
- Stones or Lattice in the garden (lay lattice on the ground and plant in the openings or use river rocks) to discourage digging.

Steps for Humanely Deterring Cats - AKA Neighbor Relations (Continued from Cover.)

Motion-Activated Sprinklers such as Critter Ridder Motion-Activated Animal Repellent & Sprinkler by Havahart or PestBye Jet Spray. Before long, cats in the neighborhood learn the boundaries of the infra-red field and are trained to stay out.

Ultrasonic Devices (also motion-activated) such as Yard Gard. When a cat is detected, the device emits a high frequency alarm that is imperceptible to people but highly startling and annoying to cats.

Natural (non-chemical) products include Coleus Canina (is a plant popularly known as the Scaredy-Cat or Pee-off plant because it emits an odor offensive to cats but not people). Place them no more than three feet apart around the area you're trying to protect. The smell of many common household items sprinkled in dry form may protect gardens or flower beds. You can try orange and lemon peels (cats dislike citrus scents), the herb rue (which can also be planted live), cayenne pepper, coffee grounds, pipe tobacco and oils, including lavender, lemon grass, citronella, peppermint, eucalyptus and mustard.

Muscovy Duck Explosion



We have been writing, talking and complaining about ducks since before an article was written in August of 2025. Yes, ducklings are cute, the ducks are fun to feed BUT...in the article you were told that the Muscovy Duck doesn't migrate so they never leave. They lay eggs three times a year of maybe 12-15 ducks. Well, here is a show and tell and Momma has 24-26 ducklings following her. Think about it for a minute and then realize that 24-26 ducks' times 3 equals 78 ducklings per duck per year. Are you sure you want to feed them so they'll stay around?

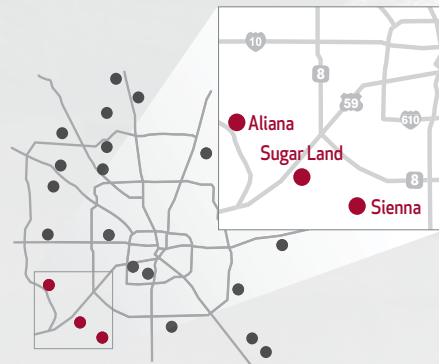

Kentucky Derby Museum Pie

Only Kern's Kitchen Inc. can lay claim to the name, "Derby-Pie" which is described as "premium chocolate and choice walnuts folded into a decadent filling, then baked in Grandma Leandra's delicate crust." The cook who submitted this recipe uses a mix of chocolate chips.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 1/2 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 pinch salt
- 2 tablespoons Kentucky bourbon or 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup chocolate chips
- 1 cup chopped pecans
- 1 partially baked 9-inch piecrust
- whipped cream or vanilla ice cream, for serving



INSTRUCTIONS:

- Preheat oven to 350°F.
- In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar. Add eggs, flour, salt, and Kentucky Bourbon (or vanilla). Add chocolate chips and nuts. Stir well.
- Pour into partially baked piecrust and bake for 30 minutes, or until center is set.
- Serve with whipped cream or vanilla ice cream.

How To Prepare for Hurricane Season in Texas



Stay Informed

The first and most crucial step in hurricane preparedness is staying informed on weather updates.

Create a Hurricane Kit

Assemble a hurricane kit well in advance of any storms.

This kit should include:

- Non-perishable food items for at least three days
- Battery-operated or hand-cranked radio
- Flashlights with extra batteries
- First aid supplies
- Prescription medications
- Important documents (identification, insurance policies, and medical records) in waterproof container
- Cash in small denominations
- Multi-tool or Swiss Army knife
- Personal hygiene items
- Maps of your local area
- Develop a Family Emergency Plan
- Create a family emergency plan that includes:
- Evacuation routes and designated meeting points

- Contact information for family members and an out-of-town contact person
- Pet care plan (if you have pets)
- Instructions for turning off utilities
- Evacuation plan for those with special needs
- Secure Your Home

Make your home more hurricane-resistant by:

- Installing hurricane shutters or boarding up windows
- Reinforcing garage doors
- Trimming trees and shrubs to prevent debris
- Securing outdoor objects that could become projectile
- Checking your roof for leaks and making repairs

Evacuation Planning

- If local authorities issue an evacuation order, it's essential to follow it promptly. Be prepared to leave your home and have a pre-determined evacuation route in mind. Take your hurricane kit, important documents, and family members or pets with you. Traffic can become congested during evacuations, so leave early to ensure your safety.
