Sign Policy in the POA

Please help us keep the neighborhood looking nice. Political signs are okay, as long as they meet the State guidelines outlined in Texas State Election Code Sec. 259.002. The 2022 Texas Gubernatorial election is November 8th, 2022, so please remove your signs until at least August 10th.

REGULATION OF DISPLAY OF POLITICAL SIGNS BY PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION.

- (a) In this section, "property owners' association" has the meaning assigned by Section 202.001, Property Code.
- (b) Except as otherwise provided by this section, a property owners' association may not enforce or adopt a restrictive covenant that prohibits a property owner from displaying on the owner's property one or more signs advertising a candidate or measure for an election:
 - (1) on or after the 90th day before the date of the election to which the sign relates; or
 - (1) before the 10th day after that election date.

Deed Restriction Violations

We receive no less than 10 complaints a week about homeowners leaving their trash cans out in the street, on the curb or in front of their home in public view. This is becoming more of a regular occurrence, specifically on days outside of the regular trash pickup schedule. Trash cans are an eyesore and should be put up once the trash collection comes and not left out in the street for days at a time. Trash cans, cardboard boxes, large trash bags, grass clippings, limbs, etc. should only be put outside the night before or day of trash pickup. Please do your part to help out and be considerate of all of your neighbors. Your POA Board would greatly appreciate your diligence with this request.

POA Rental Policy Amendment Proposition 2022

Attention POA members,

The Board has received the long-awaited Proposed Amendments to the Covenants which will allow us to restrict all types of short-term rental properties within the POA. The amendments consist of 4 sections which cover their own guidelines:

- 1. Required Lease Provisions
- 2. Subleasing Prohibited
- 3. Lessee Information
- 4. Occupancy

For these Amendments to be Lawful and filed with the state, The POA will need to secure a vote of 66% of the entire association, voting in favor of this proposition in its entirety. We currently have already collected 10% of the required votes needed through our website. It will likely take some time to secure all the required approval votes so please follow the QR code here for the link to an electronic version of the form which you can vote in favor of this proposition.

- 3. Serve Chilled & Enjoy!





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

A Few More Listings – Buyers Still Buying – 2-month snapshot of Pecan Grove

Beginning of July there are 7 listings on the market, 1 was listed this month, 3 have been on the market for over 30 days. Listings on the market for over 45 days were there when there were only 1 or 2 homes available. It is still a sellers market and will remain so for a while – again activity is different depending on the price point. Current interest rates (still low but much, much higher than they have been) will make a difference to the entry level buyer that might not be approved for as much as they were a few months ago. Again, we have pent up demand that is unlikely to disappear in the short range.

Pecan Grove stats for the past 2 months show good activity and sales. Remember this is a very small sample and price per square foot is dependent on the size and amenities of each house sold, take this number lightly as the sample is very small. Always feel free to call, text, or email for details

Trash and Recycle Information

Pecan Grove MUD trash pick-up days are Monday and Thursday. Garbage must be out no later than 7:00 am. Heavy trash is collected on both days.

For 2022, collections will continue for *every Monday* and *Thursday* regardless of holidays with the *single exception* of Thanksgiving Day, Thursday 11/24/2022, when there will be no collections.

The Recyclables pick up day depends on where you live in Pecan Grove. If you live north of Plantation Drive your recycle day is Monday. If you live on or South of Plantation Drive your recycle day is Thursday. Should you need to replace a damaged recycle cart simply call customer service at (281) 368-8397, indicate you are in Pecan Grove and they will process the request at no charge.

GFL does have a special pick-up service available at a nominal fee to collect many overweight items or other items not covered as part of the normal service. Please call their office in advance at (281) 368-8397 to arrange collection of this type of material.
