Please join us for our Pecan Grove POA Nominations Meeting at the PGMUD Building @ 751 Pitts rd. on Tuesday September 20th. The meeting will begin promptly at 6:30pm.

The POA Board election is coming up in October and we will elect three (3) Trustees. To be an eligible candidate, you must be a POA property owner. Anyone who wants to run must be nominated at the September 20th meeting to be included on the proxy and preprinted ballot. Nominations will also be accepted from the floor at the October Annual Meeting as writein candidates only. The election notice, proxy/absentee ballot and candidate biographies will be mailed at the end of September 2022.

The 2022 election will be held at the MUD Building on Tuesday, October $18\text{th}\ @\ 6:30\text{pm}.$

There are four (4) ways to cast your ballot:

- 1. in person at the Annual Meeting
- 2. assigning your proxy to an individual
- 3. assigning your proxy to the Board of Trustees
- 4. Directive Proxy/Absentee Ballot (early voting) which allows you to cast your vote as you see fit. You may also select Quorum Only which by state law is a non-voting proxy. All proxies must be received by noon Monday, October 17, 2022—NO EXCEPTIONS.

*Candidate 85-word biography - All September nominees must submit their personal biographies to the POA office or by email to pgpoa@peoplepc.com no later than 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 22nd, 2022. Your biography should promote yourself as a candidate and should not exceed 85 words.

POA Rental Policy Amendment Proposition 2022

Attention POA members,

The Board has received the long-awaited Proposed Amendments to the Covenants which will allow us to restrict all types of short-term rental properties within the POA. The amendments consist of 4 sections which cover their own guidelines:

- 1. Required Lease Provisions
- 2. Subleasing Prohibited
- 3. Lessee Information
- 4. Occupancy

For these Amendments to be Lawful and filed with the state, The POA will need to secure a vote of 66% of the entire association, voting in favor of this proposition in its entirety. We currently have already collected 10% of the required votes needed through our website. It will likely take some time to secure all the required approval votes so please follow the QR code here for the link to an electronic version of the form which you can vote in favor of this proposition.



This pot roast is an instant favorite for anyone who tries it. With just five ingredients, it doesn't get any easier to make your family a delicious meal!




Ingredients:





A Few More Listings – Buyers Still Buying – 2-month snapshot of Pecan Grove

Beginning of July there are 7 listings on the market, 1 was listed this month, 3 have been on the market for over 30 days. Listings on the market for over 45 days were there when there were only 1 or 2 homes available. It is still a sellers market and will remain so for a while – again activity is different depending on the price point. Current interest rates (still low but much, much higher than they have been) will make a difference to the entry level buyer that might not be approved for as much as they were a few months ago. Again, we have pent up demand that is unlikely to disappear in the short range.

Pecan Grove stats for the past 2 months show good activity and sales. Remember this is a very small sample and price per square foot is dependent on the size and amenities of each house sold, take this number lightly as the sample is very small. Always feel free to call, text, or email for details
